#### What's included:

- Fuel (approximately 2600km round trip)

#### What you need:

- All camping equipment
- Drinking and shower water – not all campsites have ablution facilities
- All food and all catering equipment



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Join us the Hunter's Road as we view Botswana from a different perspective, on a route that dates back to the 1800s. We will visit Makgadikgadi pans and Kukonje Island, a rocky island covered in Baobab and Camelthorn trees, which rises from the eastern stretches of the Sowa Pan in central Botswana – one of the largest pans in Africa and part of the largest network of salt pans on the globe.

### Proposed itinerary

- Day 1: Meet and convoy drive to Woodlands Campsite, Francistown
- Day 2: Drive to, and overnight on Kukonje Island, Makgadikgadi Pans
- Day 3: Head for Hunter's Road (wild camp) via Nata
- Day 4: Set off to Kasane and Chobe Game Reserve
- Day 5: Boat cruise and game drive (Chobe)
- Day 6: Return to Woodlands / Nata
- Day 7: Head for home
