Self-drive, self-catered Botswana adventure

This trip is self-catered and trailer friendly (additional R400 entry fees).



What's included:

- Camping and park entry fees
- Guide fees
- Two-way radio

What's NOT included:

- All food (except for dinner and breakfast at Stockpoort Lodge)
- All drinks
- Border fees
- Fuel (approximately 3000km round trip)

What you need:

- All camping equipment
- Drinking water
- Food and all catering equipment



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Proposed itinerary

- Day 1: Meet at Khama Rhino Sanctuary (ablutions and small restaurant)
Evening game drive
- Day 2: Depart for Makgadikgadi Adventure Camp (ablutions - hot water & flush toilets)
Sunset drive (20km) to Kubu Island for sundowners
- Day 3-4: Nxai Pan National Park – South Camp (ablutions)
- Day 5-7: Makgadikgadi Pan National Park – Khumaga Campsite (ablutions)
- Day 8: Stockpoort Lodge
Dinner (400g T-bone or Spare Ribs – other meals can be accommodated)
- Day 9: Head for home



Khama Rhino Sanctuary – ablutions

The Khama Rhino Sanctuary is a community-based wildlife project. It was established in 1992 to assist in saving the rhinoceros, restore the area to its natural state (teeming with wildlife), and provide economic benefit to the local community through tourism and sustainable use of natural resources.

It covers approximately 8 585 hectares of Kalahari sandveld and provides prime habitat for white and black rhino, more than 30 other animal and 230 bird species.



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Nxai Pan National Park – wild camp, with ablutions

Nxai Pan, once an old lakebed, is an extensive grass plain, generously dotted with acacia trees. The two small campgrounds are equipped with ablution facilities.

Makgadikgadi Camp – camps, ablutions

Enjoy the hot showers at this overnight stop in the heart of the Makgadikgadi pans, as well as the 20km drive to Kubu Island for sundowners.

Stockpoort Lodge

Comfortable accommodation and dinner of 400g t-bone/ribs included (other meals can be accommodated).
