Botswana Adventure

(Khwai, Savuti, Chobe)



This is a 15 day guided, self-drive, self-catered camping adventure through some of the best Botswana has to offer. We will cover the Makgadikgadi Pans, the Khwai Conservation Area, Savuti and Chobe Game Reserves and Elephant Sands (via Hunters Road).

What's included

- Guide
- Park and camping fees
- Chobe boat cruise and game drive

What you need

- All camping equipment and shade
- Drinking and shower water
- Food and all catering equipment
- Fuel
- Border fees (Botswana Pula / Credit Card)



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Route (approx. 3400km round trip, including game drives)

(The following distances are approximate)

- **Day 1** **630km**
Camp in the Khama Rhino Sanctuary
- **Day 2** **245km**
Make our way into the Makgadikgadi Pans and overnight at the Adventure Camp.
Once camp is set up, we will drive 20km to Kubu Island for sunset
- **Day 3** **300km**
Depart for Sitatunga Bush Camp near Maun. We will use this time to restock supplies and refuel.
- **Days 4, 5 and 6** **135km**
We head off to Khwai Conservation area to enjoy a few days relaxing and enjoying some self-drive game drives.
- **Days 7 and 8** **100km**
We drive through the thick sand to Savuti and enjoy a day of game drives
- **Days 9, 10 and 11** **180km**
Time Kasane where we enjoy a Chobe boat cruise, game drives and fishing
- **Days 12 and 13** **250km**
Time to hit the Hunter's Road for Elephant Sands
- **Day 14** **440km**
Moriti Camp site, about 5km after Martin's Drift Border Post
- **Day 15** **440km**
It's time to pack up, say goodbye and head home.

Please note that sanity prevails on all our trips, so the itinerary / route could be altered to accommodate the weather and other unforeseen factors.

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Travel requirements

- Don't forget your passports
- If you are travelling with children under the age of 18, Botswana now require an unabridged birth certificate and passport are required.
